Cortázar collaborated with numerous academic institutions giving lectures, conferences, seminars and advisory covering historic, philosophical and theoretical aspects of art. He was a key contributor to the renewal of the academic plan for National School of Fine Arts. From 1989 to 1993 he was a founding member of the Consultative Council for the Mexican National Foundation for Culture and the Arts (CONACULTA) focusing on plastic arts. During these years he was jurer for the National Plan for Creators and the National Fund for Plastic Arts. During this period he also acted as academic tutor and mentor to many young artists.
